AREA 7

CRITERIA FOR DISTRICT DEPUTY GRAND EXALTED RULER

1. Must have served as Exalted Ruler and have the status of Past Exalted Ruler and be a member of the Grand Lodge.
2. A Lodge Secretary should not be considered. The holding of another elective or appointive position might be cause for rejection.
3. Must have the support of their Lodge and its Past Exalted Rulers.
4. Must have at least three years continued activity in own Lodge and District.
5. Must have participated on Committees and/or as an Officer in the District/Association.
6. Must be a participating member of the Elks National Foundation or be an Honorary Founder thereof.
7. Candidate should be in sufficiently good health to accomplish the duties of the position. Conduct and appearance must be such that the Grand Exalted Ruler will be proud to have a representative.
8. Business and/or occupational commitments must allow the time required to serve as District Deputy Grand Exalted Ruler (DDGER).
9. Personal obligations must allow the time to serve.
10. Must have financial ability to serve in office of DDGER. (Grand Lodge reimbursement does not always cover all necessary expenses.)
11. There will be no automatic progression from any office, Lodge, District or Association and no rotation of appointment between Lodges of the District. The Grand Lodge seeks the best qualified individual.
12. Must be able to attend the next Grand Lodge Session.
13. Except in very special and unusual circumstances own Lodge must not be on probation or under the direction of a Special Representative, and must be in compliance with all of the Grand Lodge Statutes.

CRITERIA FOR VICE PRESIDENT

CALIFORNIA-HAWAII ELKS ASSOCIATION

1. Must have served as Exalted Ruler, have Past Exalted Ruler status and be a member of the Grand Lodge.
2. A Lodge Secretary should not be considered. The holding of another elective or appointive position might be cause for rejection.
3. Must have the support of their Lodge and its Past Exalted Rulers.
4. Must have at least three years continued activity in own Lodge and District.
5. Must have participated on a District or Association Committee, and/or served as an Officer of the Association.
6. Must be a participating member of the Elks National Foundation or be an Honorary Founder thereof.
7. Candidate should be in sufficiently good health to accomplish the duties of the position.
8. Business commitments must allow the time required for serving as the Association Vice President.
9. Personal obligations must allow the time to serve as the Association Vice President.
10. Must be able to attend the next CHEA Convention and Mid-Term Conference.
11. Except in very special and unusual circumstances own Lodge must not be on probation or under the direction of a Special Representative, and must be in compliance with all of the Grand Lodge Statutes.
12. Must have financial ability to serve in office of Association Vice President. (CHEA reimbursement does not always cover all necessary expenses.)
